2014 ADF WORKPLACE REMUNERATION ARRANGEMENT

The Defence Force Remuneration Tribunal makes the following Determination under section 58H of the *Defence Act 1903*. It relates to Matter No. 9 of 2014 – Workplace Remuneration Arrangement 2014-2017.

PART A - Preliminary

1. Citation

1. This Determination is DFRT Determination No. 14 of 2015, ADF Workplace Remuneration Arrangement.

4. Rates of allowance

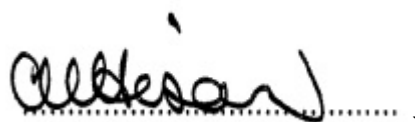
The Determinations listed in Schedule 2 to this Determination, are amended as set out in that Schedule.

5. Saved and transitional rates

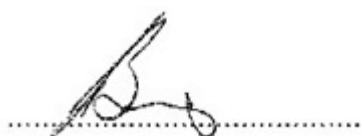
