DETERMINATION NO. 5 OF 2015

2014 ADF WORKPLACE REMUNERATION ARRANGEMENT

The Defence Force Remuneration Tribunal makes the following Determination under section 58H of the *Defence Act 1903*. It relates to Matter No. 9 of 2014 – Workplace Remuneration Arrangement 2014.

PART A - Preliminary

1. Citation

1. This Determination is DFRT Determination No. 5 of 2015, 2014 ADF Workplace Remuneration Arrangement.

2. This Determination may also be cited as DFRT Determination No. 5 of 2015.

2. Commencement

This Determination commences on 12 March 2015.

PART B - Amendment

3. Rates of salary

DFRT Determination No. 15 of 2008, *Salaries*, as amended, is amended by deleting Schedules B.1, B.3 to B.8 (inclusive), B.10, B.12 to B.18 (inclusive) and inserting the schedules in Schedule 1 to this Determination.

Schedule B.3 Part 3 ceases to have effect from 9 April 2015 in accordance with *DFRT Determination 14 of 2014 – Salaries – Removal of discounted rates*.

4. Rates of allowance

The Determinations listed in Schedule 2 to this Determination, are amended as set out in that Schedule.

5. Saved and transitional rates

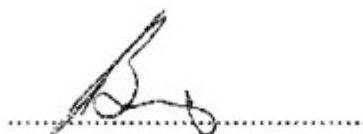
